



PHOTOGRAPHIC / VIDEOING CONSENT FORM

The following guidelines have been developed by the Australian Sports Commission (ASC) to assist sporting clubs and associations when acquiring and displaying images of participants, specifically children and young people on websites and in other publications.

Individuals featured in photographs (and their parent/guardian if under 18yrs) must have given consent for their image to be published, as personal information protection principles must be respected.

ACQUIRING & DISPLAYING IMAGES

- Permission needs to be obtained from the player and/or parent/guardian prior to taking their image.
- Ensure that the individual is provided with information regarding how the image may be used.
- Requesting that Professional photographers and/or spectators taking photographs register at an event or facility.
- Clearly outline and publicise what is considered appropriate behaviour and content to those taking photographic images.
- Do not allow unsupervised or individual access to players.
- Do not display personal information such as residential address, email address or telephone numbers without gaining consent from a parent/guardian first.
- Only use appropriate images of the player, relevant to the sport or activity, and suitably clothed.
- Reduce the ability for the direct copying of pictures from a website to another source (i.e. disable the 'right click' function).
- Provide details of who to contact if concerns or complaints of inappropriate photographic behaviour or content are raised.
